AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection A, 2004 Master Plan, and Subsection A(1), 2004 Land Use Element Plan, all of Section 169-1, Adoption; legal status, of Chapter 169, Master Plan, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for the adoption of the 2012 Master Plan and the 2012 Land Use Element Plan; and generally relating to the adoption of the Master Plan.

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1 Section 1. Be It Enacted By The County Council of Harford County, Maryland that Subsection A,
2 2004 Master Plan, and Subsection A(1), 2004 Land Use Element Plan, of Section 169-1, Adoption;
3 legal status, of Chapter 169, Master Plan, of the Harford County Code, as amended, be, and they are
4 hereby, repealed and reenacted, with amendments, all to read as follows:

5 **Chapter 169. Master Plan**

6 **§ 169-1. Adoption; legal status.**

7 A. [2004] 2012 Master Plan. The [2004] 2012 Master Plan, [dated May 2004,] as adopted
8 by County Council Bill [04-23] 12-01, is hereby declared to be the Official County Master Plan.

9 (1) [2004] 2012 Land Use Element Plan. The [2004] 2012 Land Use Element Plan,
10 [dated May, 2004,] as adopted by County Council Bill [04-23] 12-01, is hereby declared to be part of
11 the Official Harford County Master Plan. DUE TO THE INTRODUCTION OF THIS ACT PRIOR
12 TO ANY IMPLEMENTATION BY THE STATE OF MARYLAND OF PLAN MARYLAND, THE
13 SUSTAINABLE GROWTH AND AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION ACT OF 2012 AND THE
14 WATERSHED IMPLEMENTATION PLAN, IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO RECONSIDER OR
15 CONDUCT A REVIEW OF THE MASTER PLAN AND LAND USE ELEMENT PLAN PRIOR TO
16 THE EXPIRATION OF THE STATUTORY 6-YEAR REVIEW PERIOD.

17 Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date
18 it becomes law.
